Obliqua Variegated Jade Plant

Crassula ovata 'Obliqua Variegata'

Description:

An elegantly branched shrub with attractive green foliage striped in ivory and pale yellow; pinkish-white flower clusters in fall; very slow growing; an excellent choice for indoor containers and rock gardens

Features & Attributes

Obliqua Variegated Jade Plant features showy clusters of white star-shaped flowers with pink overtones at the ends of the branches from mid fall to early winter. The flowers are excellent for cutting. Its attractive succulent round leaves remain green in color with prominent white stripes and tinges of buttery yellow throughout the year.

This is a multi-stemmed evergreen houseplant with an upright spreading habit of growth. This plant can be pruned at any time to keep it looking its best.

Planting & Growing

When grown indoors, Obliqua Variegated Jade Plant can be expected to grow to be about 4 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 4 feet. It grows at a slow rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 20 years. This houseplant will do well in a location that gets either direct or indirect sunlight, although it will usually require a more brightly-lit environment than what artificial indoor lighting alone can provide. It prefers dry to average moisture levels with very well-drained soil, and may die if left in standing water for any length of time. This plant should be watered when the surface of the soil gets dry, and will need watering approximately once each week. Be aware that your particular watering schedule may vary depending on its location in the room, the pot size, plant size and other conditions; if in doubt, ask one of our experts in the store for advice. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in sandy soil. Contact the store for specific recommendations on pre-mixed potting soil for this plant. Be warned that parts of this plant are known to be toxic to humans and animals, so special care should be exercised if growing it around children and pets.
